Train the Leaders of Tomorrow, through a survey on the Rights of Nature in the heart of the Atlantic Rain Forest in Brazil.

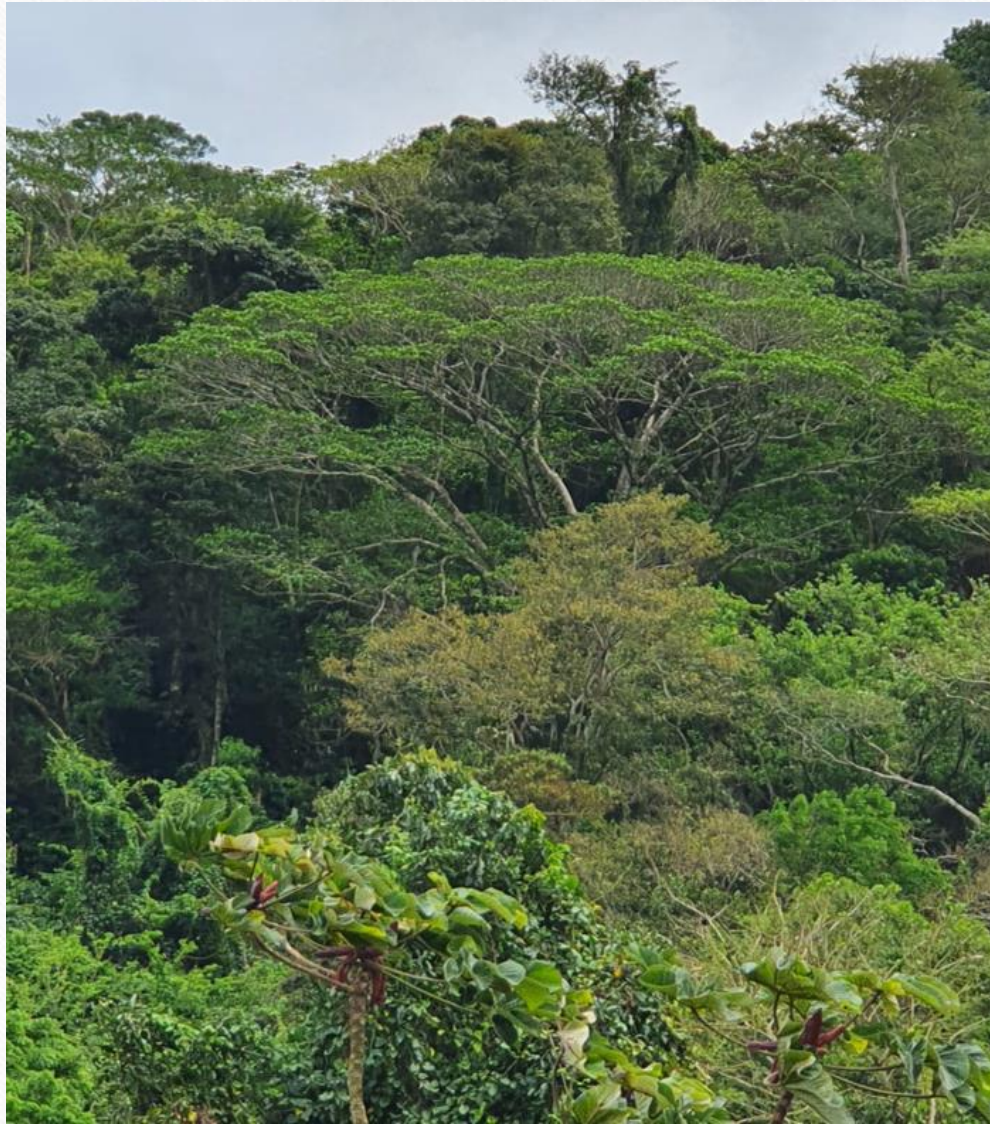
Objectif

1,361 species of animals, like jequitibás, jatobás, uricuranas, cinnamons, cedars, manacás-da-serra, guanandis, guapuruvus and juçara palm trees, shelter the jaguar, puma, muriqui, howler, ocelot, tapir, paca, raccoon, otter, toucan, Black-billed, Araponga, Jacu-açu and hundreds of other birds and about 1200 types of plants recorded by their extension

- Evening activities are dedicated to fun.
- Art, sports and cultural activities taking place in the middle of Nature
- Learning how to do in a cooperation way
- Fresh air of the Forest, the sun from the beach, pure water from the clean rivers
